Animal users are required to follow all relevant standards, including the Animal Welfare Act Regulations, Public Health Service Policy, the Guide, the Ag Guide, and their ACUC-approved protocol.

<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Anesthesia machines have been calibrated within the last 12 months and have a sticker with inspection date visible

<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	First Aid kits are available and do not contain expired materials
<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Sharps (needles, injection ports etc.) are properly stored and sharps container is not overfull

<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Cardboard boxes , including broken glass boxes, are stored off the floor to prevent soaking during mopping or water leaks
